Dear Chairman Murray

The purpose of this letter is to petition the Northampton County Board of Supervisors for reimbursement of \$358.00 for the disposal fee for waste tires illegally dumped on the Stevenson Homeplace LLC property.

Discussion

On March 4, 2016, I was notified by the County Administrator that waste tires had been illegally dumped on the Stevenson Homeplace property (tax map 30, double circle A, parcel 33), and I was directed to have the tires removed (letter attached).

I have had the waste tires removed and taken to the specified landfill site (Seaside Road landfill, Cheriton, VA). The tire disposal fee at the landfill was \$358.00. The tires were picked up and taken to the landfill by Mr. Robert (Robbie) Mapp Jr.

Dear Property Owner:

It has come to the attention of this office that a waste tire pile has been deposited on your property on Johnstontown Road near Birdsnest. A site visit was conducted and a picture was taken, a copy of which is enclosed herewith. The property is further described as being Tax Map 30 Double Circle A Parcel 33.


This waste tire pile is in violation of the *Northampton County Solid Waste Ordinance*. It is the responsibility of the property owner to see that the debris is properly disposed of as soon as possible.

This letter serves as written notification that you are in violation of the above referenced ordinance. Please give this matter your immediate attention and see that the tires are removed within thirty (30) days of receipt of this letter. Failure to comply will result in further legal action against you.

This tire pile is among a series of similar violations which have recently occurred in the County. For your information, the Board of Supervisors has already waived the tire disposal fee associated with two other instances and I would urge you to petition the Board for waiver of the disposal fees (\$2.00 per tire) after you have cleaned up the tire pile and brought the tires to the landfill for disposal.
