

The Northampton County Electoral Board met on Thursday, December 12, 2023, in the Voter Registration Office in Eastville.

The meeting was called to order by the Chair at 10:35 A.M. A moment of silence was observed.

The minutes of the Electoral Board meeting on November 8, 2023 having been reviewed by the Board were approved and signed.

Board welcomed Officer of Election Laurie Jo Litton as a guest to the meeting.

Registrar updated the Board on the efforts to fix the time synchronization issues on the electronic poll books. The vendor, Demtech, will visit the office and fix the problems.

Board considered the ballot order for the March 5 Presidential Primary. Discussion centered on whether it would be a dual primary or not. Secretary motioned to order ballots sufficient for 50% of the voting population for each party in the event of a dual primary, or 70% of voter population for a single party primary, with the understanding that we could order more if we saw a higher demand during absentee voting. Vice Chair seconded the motion, and it was approved unanimously.

Board and registrar briefly talked about the upcoming Presidential Primary, and specifically that we would L&A test the absentee machines during the week of January 15th.

Board adjourned the meeting after unanimously agreeing to meet again at 10:30, January 4th, 2024.
