What is a Comprehensive Plan?

The Comprehensive Plan is Northampton County's most important document regarding future growth, development, and change. It establishes government policy to help guide public and private activities as they relate to land use and resource utilization. The Comprehensive Plan is the basis for land development regulations (Zoning and Subdivision Ordinances) and decisions (rezonings, conditional use permits), capital improvements (schools, parks, libraries), transportation, environmental and historic resource protection initiatives. All Virginia towns, cities, and counties are required to adopt a Comprehensive Plan, and to review the plan for necessary updates every five years.


